

The concessions equipment I have and the current rates are:

- 10 – Single Barrel Soft Serve Machines - \$120 ea.
- 1 – Double Barrel Soft Serve Machine - \$250
- 2 – Smoothie/Slush Machines - \$150 ea.
- 2 - Popcorn Machines - \$50 ea.
- 2 - Sno-Cone Machines - \$50 ea.
- 2 - Cotton Candy Machines - \$50 ea.
- 2 – Shaved Ice Machine - \$50 ea.
- 1 – Hot Dog Roll-A-Grill (small) - \$25

Additional Fees:

- Delivery \$100 (SL Valley)
- Delivery \$140 (Ogden/Provo)
- Add'l Machines \$25 ea.
- Pick up Mix/Cones \$20
- Cleaning \$35 (Cart/Extra \$35)
- Extension Cords \$10

I suggest you get supplies from the following places (**with approximate costs**):

Ice Cream - [Farr-Russell Group 2575 So 300 W 484-8724 (M-F 8-4:30, Not open Saturday or Sunday)

Cost calculation:

about 24 cents for a standard serving (4 oz.), about 15 cents per small serving (2 oz.)

Supplies:

\$15 per bag of Ice Cream (2-1/2 gallon bag makes about 100 standard servings) [4 cents per ounce]  
\$9 per box #10 cones (112 standard cones) [8 cents per cone]

Sno-Cones - [Mountain States Concessions 1885 So Milestone Dr. (3050 W) Unit D 886-0464 (M-F 8-4)] (Need business account)

Cost calculation:

about 12 cents for supplies, ice additional

FYI - It takes 1/2 lb of ice per sno-cone (For large volume, I suggest you order ice from Bagley's [225 W 1530 So 487-3342] in the 35 lb bag [\$3/bag if you pick up; \$5/bag if they deliver +\$10 delivery fee]. The ice you buy at a grocery store is in a 7 lb or 10 lb bag)

Supplies:

\$8 per bottle sno-cone flavors (1 gallon will make about 100 servings) [8 cents per ounce]  
\$8 per box sno-cone cups (200 per box) [4 cents per cup]

Cotton Candy - [Mountain States Concessions 1885 So Milestone Dr. (3050 W) Unit D 886-0464 (M-F 8-4)]

Cost calculation:

about 20 cents per serving

Supplies:

\$7 per carton pre-mixed Flavored Sugar floss (about 2 lbs, makes about 40 servings) [18 cents per serving]  
-or- you can mix your own flavors with 1 level Tablespoon "flossine" per 5 lbs of white granulated sugar (I buy flossine in the 1 lb can for \$9) [can be as low as 6 cents per serving]  
\$20 per 1000 cotton candy cones -or- [2 cents per cone]  
\$40 per 1000 cotton candy bags - unprinted [4 cents per bag]

Popcorn - [Mountain States Concessions 1885 So Milestone Dr. (3050 W) Unit D 886-0464 (M-F 8-4)] – No Credit Cards

Cost calculation:

about 13 cents per serving  
about 10 servings per batch

Supplies:

\$14 for 35 lb bag (70 batches) of Orville Redenbacher popcorn seed (1 cup of seed [20 cents] per batch)  
\$10 for a gallon (32 batches) of oil (1/4 cup of oil [32 cents] per batch)  
\$10 for a gallon (about 32 batches) of Orville Redenbacher butter flavored topping (usage depends upon taste, I typically use about 1/4 cup [32 cents] per batch)  
\$6 per carton (about 2 lbs) buttered flavored popcorn salt (usage depends upon taste, I use a rounded 1/2 teaspoon [2 cents] per batch)  
\$20 per 1000 8 oz. Serving bags [2 cents per bag]

Shaved Ice - [Mountain States Concessions 1885 So Milestone Dr. (3050 W) Unit D 886-0464 (M-F 8-4)] – cash/check

Cost calculation:

about 11 cents for supplies, ice additional

FYI – I freeze the ice (well in advance) in a 4 quart Ice Cream pail (about 2/3 full) and shave it into another one. The other option is to get block ice (frozen solid, rather than compressed) and cut it into quarters (or into half, if the ice has melted a little bit).

Supplies:

\$7 per bottle sno-cone flavors (1 gallon will make about 80-100 servings) [7 cents per ounce]  
\$8 per box sno-cone cups (200 per box) [4 cents per cup]

Hot Dogs – Buy supplies from your local grocery store

This is a small machine, it will heat 10 hot dogs at a time. It takes about 10 minutes per batch (based on a 2 ounce hot dog). Increase the cooking time for larger hot dogs.
