

The Carnival Games that I have are \$20 each to rent. Games do not include prizes. I suggest looking at Zurchers or Fun Services for prizes.

Game Description:

Fishing Pond

This is a 6 ft x 6 ft PVC pipe frame with a fabric curtain. The frame is assembled in an outdoor setting by pounding a four foot length of 3/8" re-bar into the ground leaving about 3 feet of re-bar exposed. The frame slides easily over the re-bar for support. If used in an indoor setting, the frame may be affixed to a table or chairs for support. The game comes with 3 fishing poles made of a four foot length of 3/8" wooden dowel. A string is connected to one end of the dowel, and a cloths pin is attached to the other end of the string.

Toilet Toss

This game consists of a toilet seat attached to a basketball hoop (with a net attached) suspended by three legs. The toilet seat cover functions as the backboard, and rolls of toilet paper which have been covered with white duct tape are used as the balls.

Spinner

This game is made of a 12" disk attached to a 24" square made of 1/8" masonite board. The wheel has 24 evenly spaced pegs that stick out at a 90 degree angle from the face of the disk. The pegs are along the outer edge of the disk and are slowed down by a plastic flipper when the disk is spun.

Big Mouth Frog

This game is a bean bag toss through the mouth of a big frog. The frog is painted on a 3 foot square piece of vinyl, and is suspended on a PVC frame. This game has a small stand to keep it upright indoors, and can be slid over re-bar supports in an outdoor setting.

Ring A Rung

Sometimes called Dingle-Balls, Ladder Golf, or Norwegian Horseshoes. This game is played by gently tossing an 18" piece of 1/4" nylon rope that has a golf ball attached to each end, toward a three tiered PVC frame. The tiers are about 16 inches apart vertically. The objective is to get the rope to encircle any of the tiers. Scoring can be done several ways, but the most common is to score 1 point for one tier, 2 points for the second tier, and 3 points for the last tier. Points scored by the opponent on the same tier will cancel each other out. The frame includes a small stand to keep it upright.

Spud Bowl

Bowling with a twist. The game is played by setting up plastic bowling pins (or you can use 2-liter plastic soda bottles) in the standard ten-pin formation. The bowler stands 10-15 feet away, and bowls with a raw baking potato (the largest you can find). Each turn uses 2 tosses of the potatoes.

Gnip-Gnop

This game has 10 tumblers arranged on a table like bowling pins. The playing surface has a backboard attached. Players have three throws of the ping pong ball. To score, the ball must bounce (first) off of the table surface, then it must bounce (second) off of the backboard, and finally, it must land and stay inside of any one of the tumblers

Spill The Milk

This is a bean-bag toss. Player must tip over the milk bottle to score. Each turn consists of two throws of the bean bag.

Knock 'Em Off

Wooden bottles are stacked in a pyramid on a short stool. Players stand about 15-20 feet away, and must knock all of the milk bottles off of the stool. Players have two throws of the ball.

Pick A Pop

This game consists of a playing surface 18" square with 200 holes. Individual all-day suckers(lollipops) are placed in the holes. Players pay, then get to pick any pop, and remove it from the hole, if it has been previously marked with a pen on the bottom of the stick, then the player may keep the sucker, if not specially marked, the pop is returned to the playing area (not necessarily in the same hole from which it came. (This game is the same playing surface as Hoop It).

Hoop It

This game consists of an 18" square playing surface. A medium sized stuffed animal is placed on the playing box, and the player has one turn to throw a small hoop around the stuffed animal, and have it completely ring the hoop. To win, the hoop must come to rest completely flat on the table, and circle the hoop entirely. (This game is the same playing surface as Pick A Pop).

Flip A Disk

This game consists of a portable regulation sized disc golf hole, and a frisbee. Player must throw the frisbee and it must land in the basket of the disk golf hole to score.

#### Duck Pond

This game is heavy to move. It consists of a duck pond, with removable legs, a small motor to circulate the water, and plastic ducks. Ducks have a number (1-6) on the bottom of each. Players pick any duck, and receive the prize that corresponds to that particular duck. \*They do NOT win the duck\*. Odds of winning a specific prize are controlled by the number of ducks with a specific number. Note: after the duck is picked, do not immediately return it to the pond, wait for a few plays before returning ducks, in order to maintain the mystery of which specific number is on a specific duck.

#### Tic-Tac-Toe

This game is a wooden box divided into 9 squares. Player has three softball size whiffle balls. Balls are dropped into the box, and the player must get three in a row (across, vertical, or diagonal) to win.
